Challenge the one-size-fits-all approach to learning which is outmoded and harmful

Explore alternative methods of learning & examining, e.g. more coursework options

Push for up-to-date supervisor and DoS training centred on student needs

Demand stronger support for disabled students and those facing academic difficulties

Collaborate with academics, faculties & students to challenge the lack of diversity in our curricula – we deserve to and should be hearing a greater variety of voices

Regularly meet with the Autonomous Campaigns (BME, LGBT+, Women's, DSC, iCUSU) to work on ideas and action plans

Launch a campaign platforming academics from non-typical backgrounds and crowdsourcing alternative reading lists

STUDENT-LED CHANGE AND HANDS-ON SUPPORT

I WILL:

De-clutter the Faculty Rep network so you know who represents you at every level

Offer more support and resources to Reps and communicate with them regularly

Run a comprehensive education survey and termly Education Forums to find out what matters to you

Set up online subject peer support groups

I WILL:

Campaign for feedback on examinations and clearer marking criteria

Collaborate with faculties to run free writing, dissertation and study skills workshops for Freshers and anyone who needs them

Continue pushing for more equity in teaching provision across colleges

Work with colleges to raise more awareness of Reasonable Adjustments for students who need them, and make sure they are provided
