Motion to fund male survivors support group

CUSU Notes

1. That Council resolved last term to support the foundation of a support group for male survivors of sexual assault;
2. That Council allocated £250 as requested, for training and running costs (such as food & drink for meetings, and printing);
3. That training has proved more expensive than expected, with a quote of £350 from Safeline;
4. That this price has already been negotiated down from £495;
5. That training has been booked for the 21st of October;
6. That other avenues for funding have been considered and researched, but none is possible;
7. That CUSU LGBT+ has temporarily plugged this £100 gap;
8. That CUSU LGBT+'s budget was cut last year.

CUSU Believes

1. That continued support for this society is of vital importance;
2. That CUSU LGBT+ should not have to bear the financial burden for this independent initiative.

CUSU Resolves

1. To further allocate £150 from this year's free budget to the society, in order to cover the remaining costs and any additional running costs.
